General Guidelines

Reservations, Deposit, and Cancellations

Reservations may be arranged through the Community Center office by calling 842-2550. Reservations must be made by individuals over 18 years old.

A deposit of one-half of the rental fee is required at the time an event is scheduled. The balance will be required one month prior to the event.

Deposits will be fully refunded if the cancellation occurs 90 days or more prior to the event and the room can be reserved with another comparable event.

Events cancelled from 30-90 days of the scheduled event will forfeit 50% of the deposit, except for wedding receptions where the party will forfeit full deposit.

Events cancelled 29 days or less prior to the event will forfeit full deposit.

Decorations

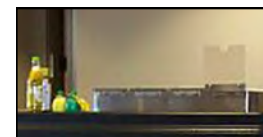
No tapping or tacking on walls, ceilings or surfaces in any of the rooms, gallery or atrium. Confetti and glitter are not allowed on the tables.



All candles are required to have glass globes or hurricane lamps. No open flames are allowed.

Beverage Service

All beverage service must end one half hour before the end of the scheduled event. The facility closes at midnight.



All alcoholic beverages must be dispensed by an insured beverage service.

All alcoholic beverages must be consumed inside the building. Events serving alcohol require an additional \$100 cleaning fee.

Room Amenities

Tables and chairs are included in the cost of the room rental.

A portable 18'x18' dance floor is optional. Additional amenities; such as, portable bar, linens, table service, table mirrors, cocktail tables, audio visual equipment, etc. are available at an additional fee.



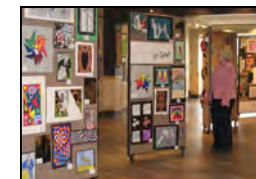
Special Needs

A special hearing loop is built into the facility.

Handicapped seating is available in the Acacia Auditorium.

Liability/Damage

The Community Center reserves the right to inspect and control all functions. Liability for and damage to the premise will be the responsibility of and charged to the sponsoring person or organization.



A security deposit of \$200 is required for all large events.

The Community Center will not assume responsibility for the damage or loss of any merchandise or articles left in the facility.

Arrangements for the security of exhibits, merchandise or articles set up for display can be made prior to the event.

Mackinaw Ballroom Rental Options

This 4,899 square-foot ballroom on the main level can accommodate from 200 to 450 people, depending on room setup. It has become a favorite

site for wedding receptions and fundraising events because of its elegant surroundings with affordable pricing. This room is also suitable for seminars, business luncheons and dinners, retirement parties, rehearsal dinners, and other large gatherings. The room can be divided in up to six sections to accommodate various functions. The atrium and gallery areas can also be rented along with the ballroom for added space for an additional \$50.

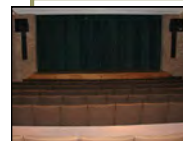
