Municipal Marina Slip Reservation Rules

A lottery system will be used to obtain a slip reservation at the Grand Haven Municipal Marina for the 2010 Coast Guard Festival. It is important to note that it is for this year only. Changes may or may not be made for future years.

NO BOATS 50' OR OVER SHOULD APPLY.

The reservation rules for the festival are as follows:

1. The reservations will be for seven (7) days; August 1 – 8, 2010, 1:00 p.m. – 12:00 p.m.
2. Slip fees must be paid when vessel arrives at the marina; fees are non-refundable.
3. Vessels must arrive by 6:00 p.m. on the 1st of August or they may forfeit their slip.
4. Vessels should not be left unoccupied for periods exceeding 24 hours.
5. If the vessel's overall length is misrepresented, the vessel will be required to leave the facility and forfeit any fees paid. (Overall length includes pulpits and platforms.)
6. Only one lottery entry is allowed per boat, and you may only bring one entry. **Bring vessel registration.** Vessel registration numbers must be filled in. Dealer License registration numbers will only be allowed to be used on one boat, they are not transferable to more than one entry.
7. The boat drawn in the lottery must be the boat that is docked in the marina. The MC numbers on the entry form must match the MC numbers on the boat that is docked. If there is a discrepancy, the owner will be required to leave.
8. Violation of the rules will result in forfeit of all entries.

The lottery will be held Saturday, May 15, 2010 at 10:00 a.m. Doors open at 8:00 a.m. at Grand Haven City Hall, 519 Washington. The drawing will be held in Council Chambers. To enter into the lottery a person must hand-deliver, by 10:00 a.m., an entry form (***only one entry per boat, one entry per person and MC or DL registration numbers can only be used one time***). A number will be assigned to each entry. No entries will be taken by mail. It is not necessary to stay for the drawing, but a person must present the entry form in order to enter in to the lottery. Vessels will be placed on a list in the order drawn. Following the drawing, the slips will be assigned and a letter will be sent confirming the slip assignment. If you elect not to take the slip, your name will be removed from the list.
